

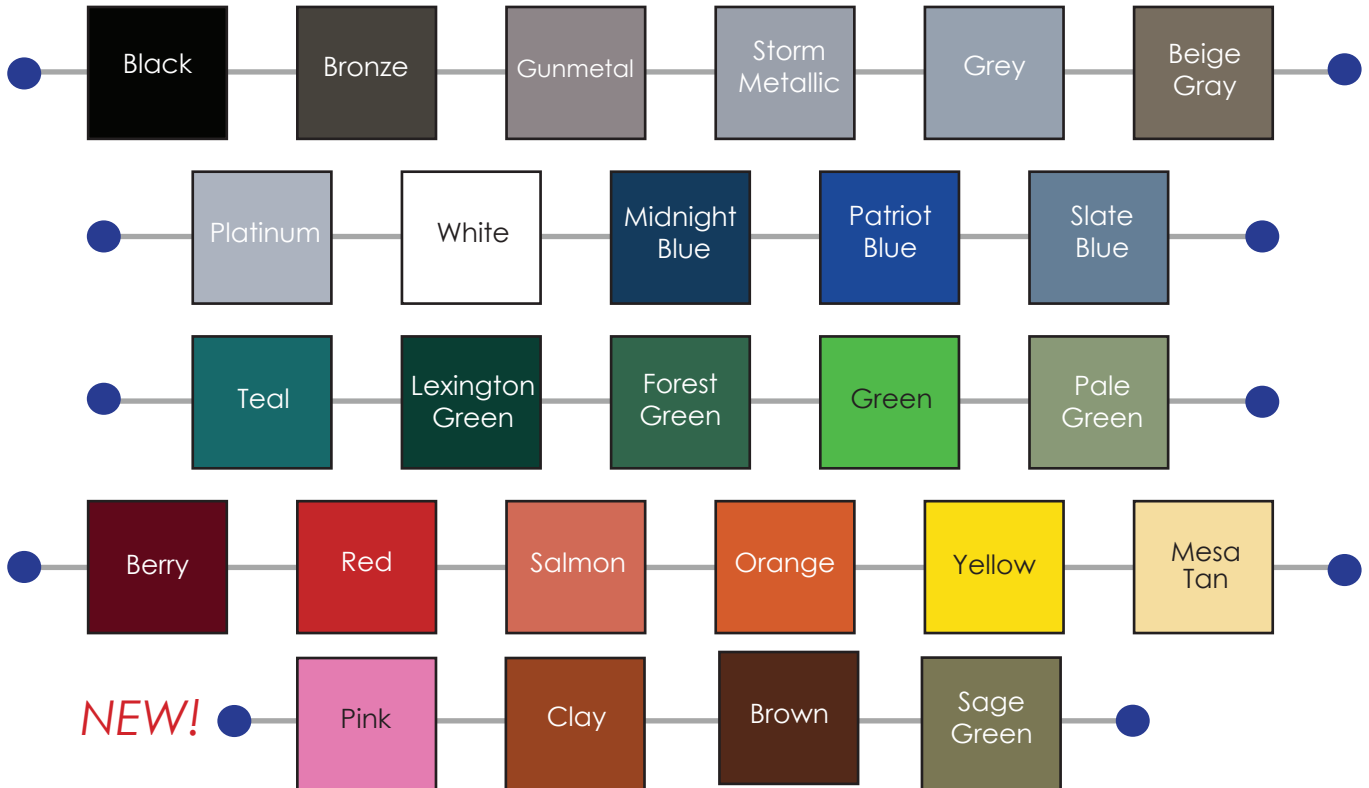
Standard Material & Finishes

Galvanized

Withstanding the elements with little to no maintenance, our galvanized products are durable and weather to a battleship grey. For this finish, the product will have vent holes that will allow draining after a hot-dip in the molten zinc tank. A galvanized product is an economical choice that resists rust. This finish comes with a 5-year warranty.

Recycled Plastic

One of two recycled plastic styles, the original recycled plastic is a high-density polyethylene material (HDPE) made from post-industrial and/or wide spec material. HDPE makes up, on average, 96% of this type of board. The other 4% is colorant with UV inhibitors and a blowing agent.



Enhanced Recycled Plastic

The second recycled plastic style is enhanced recycled plastic. These boards are crafted to resemble wood more visually in color and boast more unique and true wood grains. This in turn gives this material a bit more natural look than its counterpart, recycled plastic.

Ipe Wood

Pronounced "ee-pay" this olive-brown wood from South America weathers to a beautiful silver grey. Three times harder than oak, ipe is the perfect choice for outdoors, where it resists weather, heavy use and vandalism.



Thermally Modified Wood

Thermally modified wood is wood that has been heated to high temperatures to enhance its durability, stability, and resistance to decay without the use of chemicals. Sourced from the U.S., this process makes the wood less prone to warping or weathering, making it superior to untreated wood for long-lasting outdoor applications.
